FREE SCHOOL MEALS/FUNDING FOR SCHOOL

All Key Stage 1 children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are eligible to receive free school meals. However, if you are in receipt of one or more of the benefits listed and you do not receive Working Tax Credits, your child's school could benefit from Pupil Premium funding to support your child just by filling in an application form.

If you are in receipt of one or more of the benefits listed and you **do not** receive Working Tax Credits, please complete the application form below. If unsure, please contact the School Meals Team on 01872 323298 or email schoolmeals@cornwall.gov.uk – the team will be able to check your entitlement to claim.

- ✓ Income support
- ✓ Income-Based Jobseeker's Allowance (not Contribution Based)
- ✓ Income-Related Employment & Support Allowance (not Contribution Based)
- ✓ Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income (as shown on your award letter from the Inland Revenue – TC602) of no more than £16,190.
- ✓ Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- ✓ Support via Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act.
