I wrote to you recently to share the fantastic news that the school would be working closely with a qualified Mental Health Practitioner.

The mental health and emotional well-being of our pupils is incredibly important to us. We want a school environment where pupils feel nurtured and supported. This is why we fought so hard to secure the support from this new NHS service. I am delighted to be able to share that we will continue our work with the Mental Health Support Team next year.

Emma Counsell has been working with us since March. We have been so impressed with the work she has done – not only helping pupils develop key skills to help manage their own emotional wellbeing, but also delivering training to staff to ensure that we all have the expertise and knowledge to best support our pupils.

We know from recent safeguarding audits, pupil voice sessions, and the work Emma has already done with our pupils, that children speak positively about their experience of school. However, we are always looking for ways to improve and develop what we offer in school. For this reason, we feel it is important that as parents/carers, you have the opportunity to share your views and opinions on how the school currently supports pupils and explore ideas for how this could be developed further.

We all want the same thing – for the children in our school community to grow into confident, self-assured and resilient young people. Our best chance of achieving this is through working together, so we would love to hear your views. Emma Counsell is holding a parent/carer open afternoon on Tuesday 9th of July. Sadly, I am visiting schools in Plymouth and will not be able to attend, but I will be meeting with Emma the following week to discuss the ideas shared.

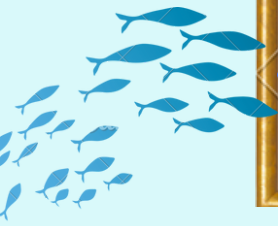
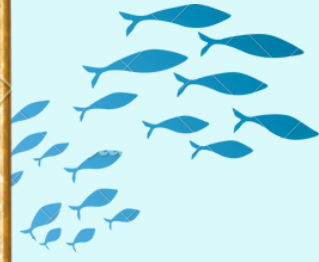
