For this reason, we always encourage visitors to come out and review our provision to ensure that it is of the highest quality. This week, we welcomed the CELT Safeguarding Lead, Amy Daniels, into school. She spent some of the day observing lessons, but most of her time was spent speaking and meeting with pupils, hearing about their experiences of school.

Amy spoke to many children, across all the year groups. Whilst we pride ourselves on the high standard of teaching and learning at Mevagissey School, the most important thing to us is that children have a positive experience of school. This is the reason we organize events like those coming up in the next few weeks: a trip to the Minack Theatre; a day of Circus Skills for KS1 (a huge thank you to the PTA for their hard work in making this happen!).

Amy's feedback on the children's thoughts and feelings about school were a delight to hear. Amy said all the children she met were 'oozing with positivity' when talking about school. They told her that they 'felt safe'. She commented that 'the warm relationships between pupils and staff were so clear to see', and that visiting Mevagissey School always 'fills her with joy'.

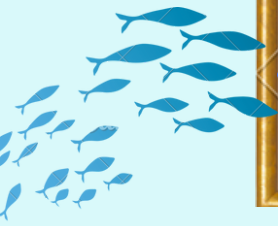
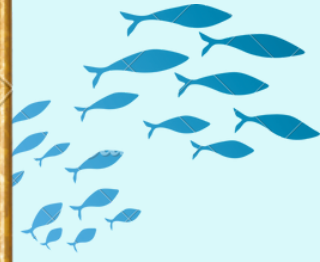
