Measuring mass:


What is the mass of the orange?



The mass of the orange is 5 cubes.


Full and empty:

Which do you think can hold more marbles?



The box has a greater capacity.

Compare volume:

Glass A has less juice than Glass B. Glass B has more juice than Glass A.

Compare mass:



The mass of the pear is 4 cubes.




The mass of the grape is I cube.

The mass of the pear is greater than the mass of the grape.

The pear is <u>heavier</u> than the grape.


Measure capacity:

4 cups of water fill the jug.



The capacity of the jug is 4 cups of water.

Compare capacity:
