I thought that this week, rather than describe the brilliant learning taking place in the classrooms, I'd share some photographs!

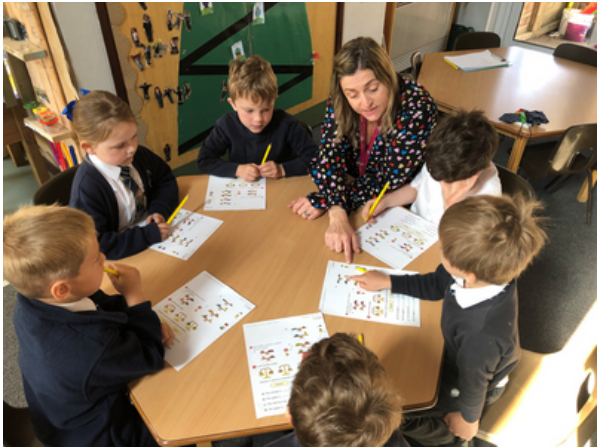
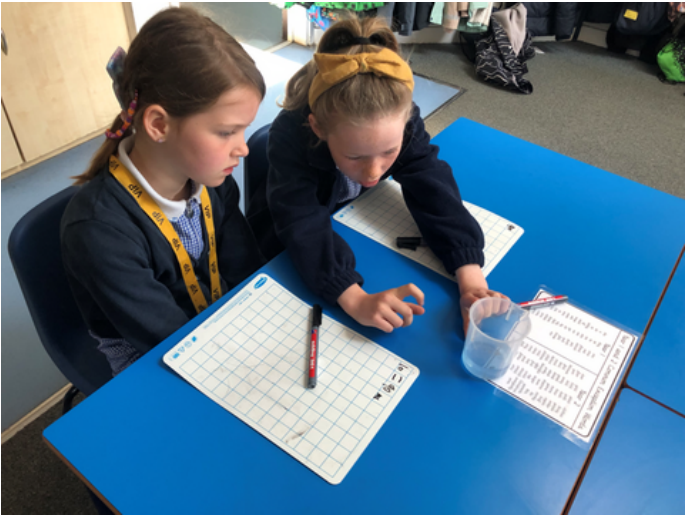
