What are materials used for?	Materials are used for different purposes based on their properties (glass = windows, wood = floors, metal = cans, coins)	
What properties of materi- als make them suitable for a par- ticular use?	Glass can be used to make windows because it is transparent . Rulers can be made from wood , plastic or rub- ber because these materials are smooth and can be cut straight. Spoons can be made from metal because it is waterproof and easy to clean but also plastic because it is light and cannot hurt children's growing teeth.	
How can you change the shape of materi- als?	The shape of some materials can be changed when they are stretched , twisted , bent and squashed . <u>stretch</u> wist <u>bend</u> squash
