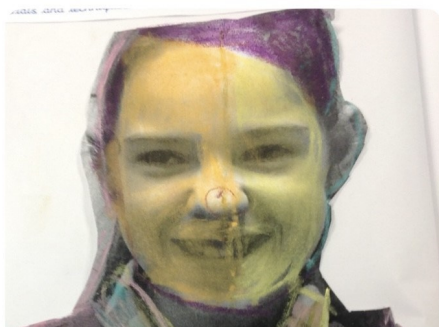
Lobster Class

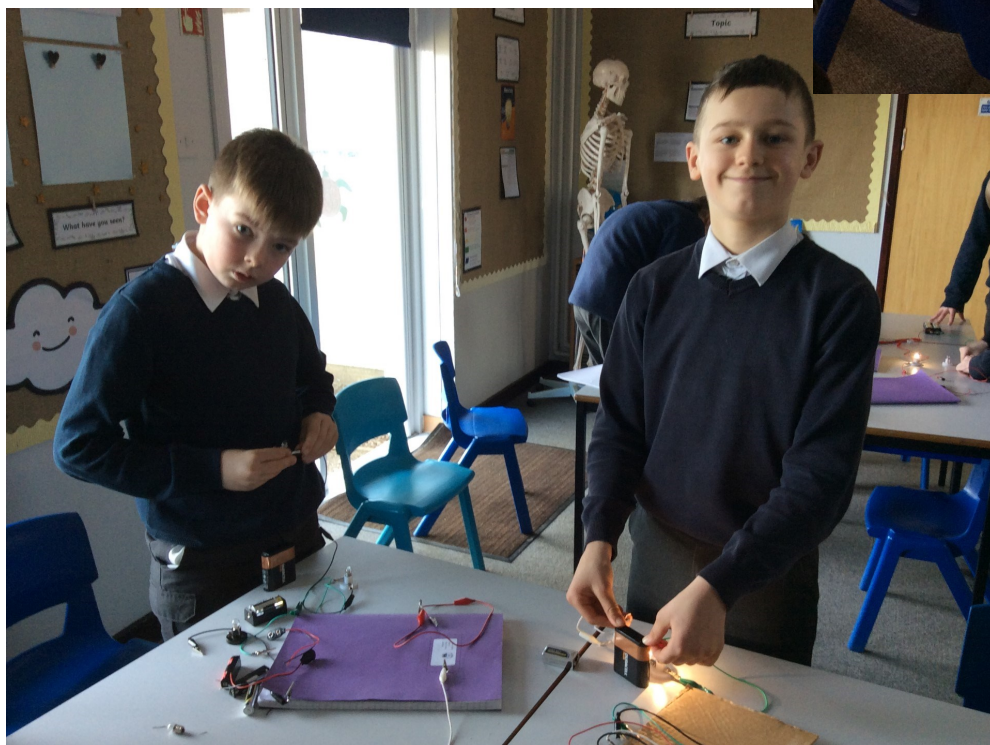
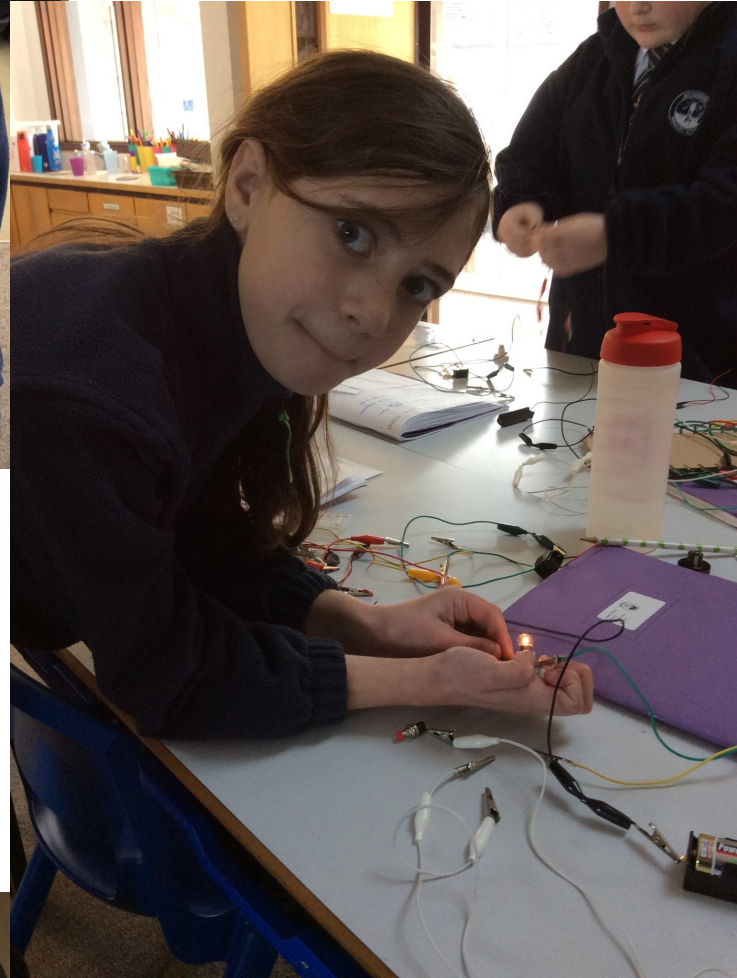
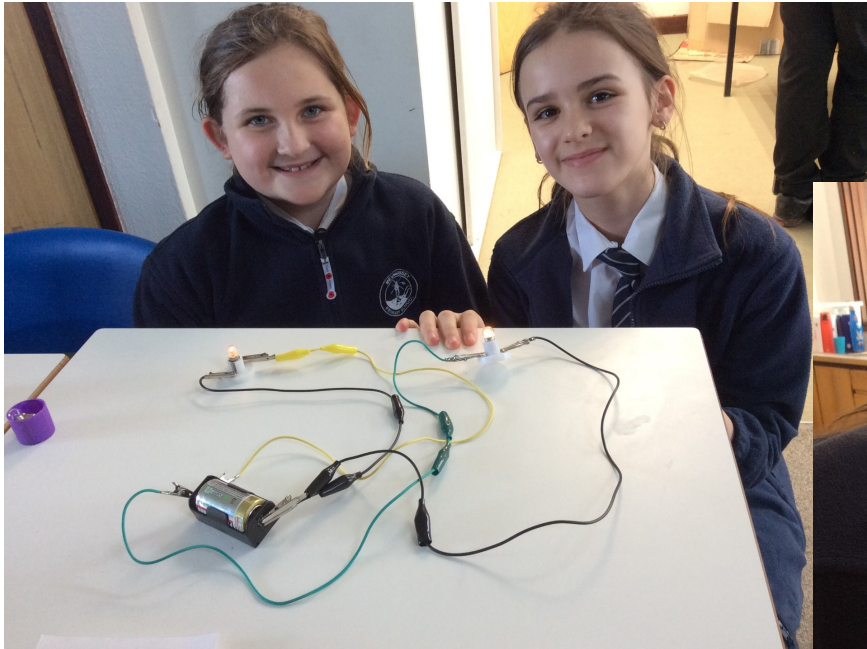


Seals Class have been having some fun making self portraits using different materials and techniques.
