Years, months, weeks and days:



One month is the same as 4 weeks.

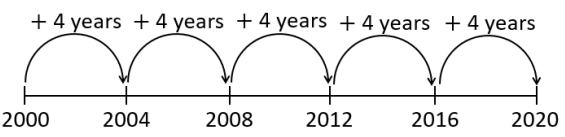
Do you agree with Kim?

February has 28 days but all the other months have more than 28 days.



1 week = 7 days
4 weeks = 7 days × 4 = 28 days.

One month is usually 4 weeks plus 2-3 days.



There are **365** days in a year.

There are **366** days in a leap year.

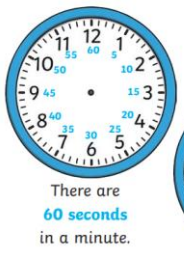
Month	Number of days

February	28
March	31
April	30
May	31
June	30
July	31
August	31
September	31
October	31
November	30
December	31

30 days has September, April, June and November, all the rest have 31 except February, 28 days here or 29 in each leap year.

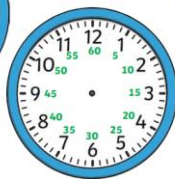


We can use the rhyme to help us to complete the table.

Hours, minutes and seconds:

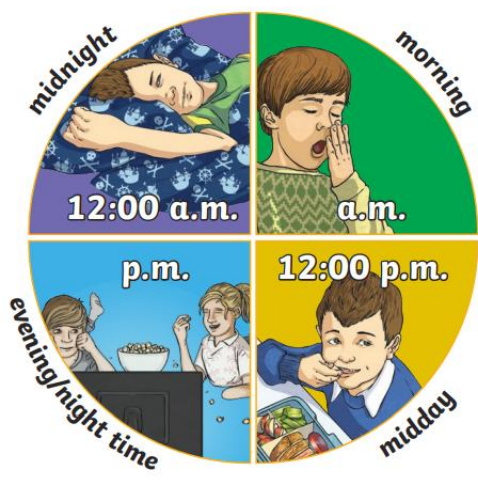


There are **60** minutes in an hour.

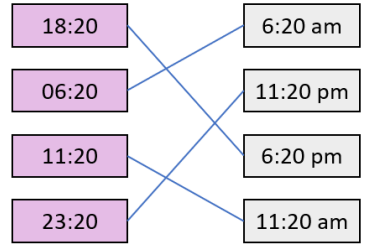


Convert between analogue and digital times:

There are 24 hours in a day.

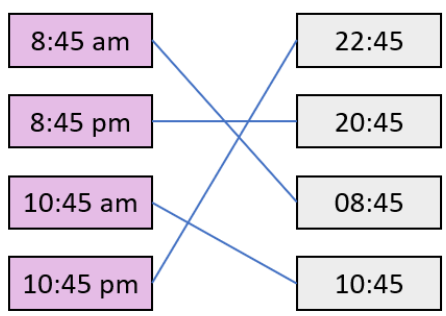


Convert from 24-hour clock:



To convert from a 24-hour clock time, I subtract 12 from the hours if the time is 13:00 or later.

Convert to 12-hour clock:



To convert to the 24-hour digital clock, I add 12 to the hours if the time is between midday and midnight.
