This week at School Headteacher's message

Last Summer, we were delighted to confirm that Little Nippers Pre-School would become part of the Mevagissey School family, joining forces with not only the school, but also joining our Multi-Academy Trust, CELT.

One of CELT's key mission statements is 'Learning together to help every child achieve more'.

In the short period of time we have been working alongside Little Nippers, we have been able to draw on and learn from their expertise and experience. Members of their team have supported us in school, and we hope to give our staff who have historically worked on the school site opportunities to pop in and see the fantastic work they are doing in the Pre-School. There is so much we can learn from one another. It is this collaboration and sharing of skills that will ensure the children we serve get the very best possible start to their school journey.

This really is an exciting time for us. Working together, we can develop the Little Nipper/Mevagissey School offer in a way that was not possible before the merger. Children now begin their journey with us at the age of 2. Most will finish their journey when they are 11. What a privilege and honour it is to play a part in supporting and shaping the children in these crucial years of their life.

Just this week, we held meetings to discuss the wider experiences and opportunities that we provide for the children. We have been relentlessly ambitious when designing and implementing our expectations around quality of learning opportunities in the classroom. We are now desperate to ensure that we match this with quality experiences outside of the classroom. We firmly believe that if we are to best support the children with their social and emotional wellbeing, school must be about more than great lessons! Day trips, workshops, residentials – these are all the perfect vehicles to build friendships, resilience and curiosity. As I shared with the Parish Council a few weeks ago, it is not the Maths lessons on Fractions that the children will remember when they leave school, but more the school residentials to Barton Hall, Okehampton, London: taking part in the school play; diving into beach schools, and spending quality time with their friends.

With the help of Little Nippers and School Staff, the PTFA, and the Governors, we are creating a passport of experience, a pledge to the children that their time with us will be both fun and educational. It will map out each year of their journey with us, outlining opportunities and experiences that we will provide for them. We will be listening to the children, asking them what they want to feature on the passport, what experiences they think are important and would like to enjoy, and also we are interested to listen to you as parents and carers – what experiences/opportunities do you feel children and young people should have access to?
