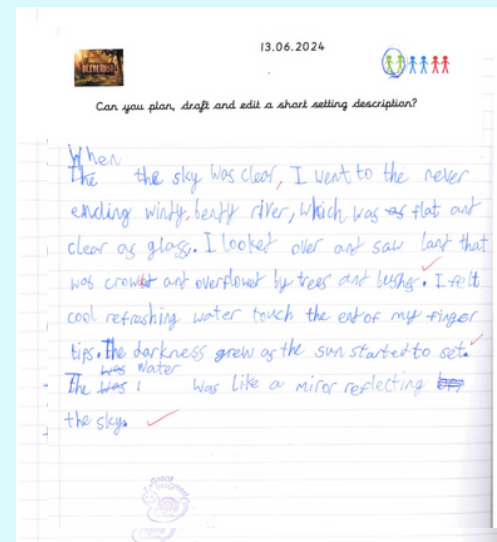


Kindness Cup goes to the whole of Lobster Class for kindly helping tidy the hall at lunchtime
